Introduction

The Devaki Warrier Memorial was registered as a charitable society in 2002 in memory of the veteran freedom fighter and Women Activist Smt. Devaki Warrier who died on 25th December 2001. She was born in Palghat District as the eldest daughter of Arya Pallom and Pallath Krishnan Namboodiri who were leaders of the renaissance movement in the Namboodiri Community. Devaki Warrier joined the Vardha Asram of Mahatma Gandhi at the age of 12. She continued her studies there and by the age of 16 she was a leader of the Indian National Congress and was co-ordinating women all over India under the Party. Later she was sent to Chennai for studies in Medicine There she became an active member of the Students Federation. She was councillor of the Thiruvananthapuram Corporation in the 70's representing the Medical College Ward. During this period her husband, the most respected Dr. P.K.R. Warrier was working in the Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram. It was under her dynamic leadership that the Kerala Working Women's Association was formed in 1973, bringing the working women of Thiruvananthapuram. city under one umbrella. Women employees of Central Government and State Government offices and Public Sector undertakings took membership in K.W.W.A. and started a working women's hostel and two creches in 1973 itself. Now a family counselling centre and a short stay home 'Sahaja' also have been added to its activities

2. Devaki Warrier Memorial Literary Award 2013

From 2005 onwards 'Devaki Warrier Memorial Literary Award for Women' is being given with a view to promote the talents of women. The 2013 the award was given to the article on the best criticism of women characters in Malayalam novel. There were 20 entries from all over Kerala.

The prizes were distributed by Smt. P.K. Sreemathi, MP on 12th June. The judging committee members Dr. P.S. Sreekala and Smt. Lekha Narendran spoke on the occasion.

3. Birth day Celebration on 12-6-2013

The birthday of Devaki Warrier was celebrated on 12-6-2013 at Students Centre at P.M.G. Junction. The Meeting was inaugurated by Smt. P.K. Sreemathi. Smt. T.N. Seema, MP distributed the gifts to the staff and also to Smt. P. Ambika who secured two gold medals in the veterans sports meet. A very special reception was arranged to felicitate Smt. Sugatha Kumari who had been awarded the prestigious 'Saraswathy Samman' for the year. She also distributed the financial help of Rs. 1000 to each patient who were inmates in our institution.

The cultural events performed on the occasion included Thayampaka by two girls (Gopika & Nayana), variety entertainment programmes presented by Balasanghom - Venal Thumbikal of Neyyattinkara Taluk and recitation of songs and poems by the members of Devaki Warrier Memorial and the inmates. The meeting was presided by Smt. G.K. Lalitha Kumari. Smt. T. Radhamony delivered the welcome speech and Smt. P.N. Sarasamma expressed vote of thanks. Over 300 persons had attended the meeting. Free accommodation and food is being provided to poor cancer/heart patients who undergo treatment in Regional Cancer Centre, Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Science & Technology and Govt. Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram. The expenditure involved is being met through contributions from good hearted persons on special occasions pertaining to them. eg. death anniversary of dear ones, wedding anniversary, birth day etc. During the period of report 160 RCC patients, 12 SCTIMST patients and three patients of Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram along with 252 bystanders were provided accommodation here. Accommodation is made available to 40 persons at a time. Smt. Ayisha Rajan & Smt. Indiramma manage the affairs of Sradha with dedication.

TRIDA Visram Sanketh

A four storyed building of TRIDA has been taken on rent by us from 1-9-2008. Accommodation is available to 70 persons at a time in this building. The amount of rent now being paid is Rs. 39734/- An amount of Rs. 40,000 is being sponsored by Santwana Kuwait, a charitable institution of Kuwait Malayalees for this purpose every month. We express our special thanks to them. During the period of Report 832 RCC patients and 158 SCTIMST patients and 1790 bystanders availed the facility of free food and accommodation here. 'Souhrida Vedi' of Chalakkuzhy Road is donating one sack (75 kg) of rice & 25 kg of green gram every month. 'Jyothis' a group of young employees of Technopark donates the cost of medicines and blood for the patients on request. Smt. Indira Lekshmi manages the affairs of Visram Sanketh with the help of Smt. Sujatha, Anitha and Radha.

Ambulance

The ambulance donated by the State Bank of Travancore,

Thiruvananthapuram on 26-7-2010 is being used for free transportation of patients to RCC and back. The salary of the driver and cost of petrol are being met from donations received for the purpose. Now considerable expenditure arises for repair and maintanance of the vehicle also. Efforts to obtain a new Ambulance has not been fruitful so far.

December 25-Death Anniversary of Devaki Warrier

Smt. Sarala Madhusoodanan daughter of MRB delivered the key note address on the occasion. Smt. Nazimunnisa and Prof. Chandra also spoke. Thirty members participated.

Cancer detection and awareness camp

A cancer detection camp and awareness class was conducted at Poovachal Mohan Clinic, along with Kerala Sasthra Sahithya Parishad. The RCC team was led by Dr. Kalavathy. 250 persons attended the camp. Apart from papsmear test by RCC, Blood Pressure, Cholesterol and Diabetic test were sponsored by Mohan Clinic for all the participants. The camp was a big success.

Palliative Care Volunteers Meet

The Devaki Warrier Memorial was affilliated to the Trivandrum Initiative in Palliative Care (TIPC and our five members attended the reception committee meeting held on 15-3-2014 at VJT Hall for the state meet of the Palliative Care volunteers at Thiruvananthapuram in May 2014. Smt. T. Radhamony and Smt. Padmini Varkey were elected as executive committee members of the reception committee.

Condolence meeting in memory of J. Saradamma and S.K. Thantry

A condolence meeting on the sad demise of Smt. J. Saradamma and Sri. S.K. Thantry was held on 12-2-2014.

Sri. P.G.N. Varma and Smt. Lalitha Sadasivan spoke on the occasion. Smt. J. Saradamma was the President of All India Democratic Women's Assocation Tvm Dist. She had worked for a very long period with Devaki Warrier for the upliftment of the down trodden. Sri. S.K. Thantry was one of the founder members of D.W.M. He had contributed 800 books and one big Almirah to our library. Until he was laid up he used to visit the institution every day.

Web site

Steps have been initiated to launch a website for D.W.M. Smt. Parvathi Devi has volunteered to work for the same. The work is almost over. It is expected that the launching of the website can be done within a couple of months.

Documentary on Devaki Warrier

Smt. V. Sobhana, Committee member put up a proposal for producing a documentary on Devaki Warrier and the institution in the committee meeting held on 10-1-2014. The committee agreed to the proposal and the work is in progress.

Book on Devaki Warrier - 'Idaratha Ichasakthi'

The 1st impression of the book printed by 'Samatha' a women's collective was completely sold out. A second edition of 1000 copies has been printed during the year. A royalty of Rs. 15,000/- has been received from Samatha.

Devaki Warrier Memorial Library

A library with more than 8000 books and a reading room with six news papers and several magazines functions inside the Chalakuzhy Road building. The library is affiliated to Kerala State Library Council. During the period of report the library was degraded to 'B' grade from 'A' grade by the Library Council since the number of books issued to members was not adequate.

Conclusion

Since its formation in 2002, the institution is growing slowly but steadly with the whole hearted support of the members and well wishers. An amount of Rs. 10,09,201 + 4,80,000 has been received during the period as donation. This amount was collected without any strain on the part of the managing committee. In fact, major portion of the amount was remitted at our office by the donors themselves. Progressive political parties and other organisations in Tvm. Dist. approve and appreciate our work and also extend helping hand. We work in co-operation with other organisations in the field eg. Asraya, Souhrida Vedi, Sujith Smaraka Foundation, Karuna Charties, Abhaya etc. The Residents Association of Chalakkuzhy road and the Janamaitri Police of Medical College are ever ready to help us. We express our sincere thanks to them.

There are some decisions taken by the executive committee which we were not able to implement.

1. Starting a Palliative Care team for the Chalakkuzhy ward.

2. Documentation of the patients with details like day of 1st arrival, nature of disease, duration of treatment, particulars of recovery etc. I sincerely hope that, soon we will be able to take up these projects also. Thanks once again for the whole hearted support of all.
